RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-013**

AMENDING STREETScape COMMITTEE RESOLUTION, NO 2020-R-011

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLANCO, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A LOCAL STREETScape PROGRAM AND MASTER STREETScape PLAN WHICH WOULD RESULT IN THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION AND BEAUTIFICATION OF THE BLANCO HISTORIC DISTRICT WHILE PROTECTING AND ENHANCING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE CITY AND ESPECIALLY THOSE BUSINESSES ADJACENT TO THE COURTHOUSE AREA. BY THIS RESOLUTION, THE COUNCIL CHARGES AND AUTHORIZES THE COMMITTEE TO COORDINATE, COLLABORATE, AND PARTNER WITH APPROPRIATE CITY, COUNTY AND STATE AGENCIES, LOCAL BUSINESSES AND INTERESTED COMMUNITY CITIZENS IN THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE COMMITTEE OBJECTIVES.

WHEREAS, the Blanco Historic District was established in 1986, and

WHEREAS, the Blanco Historic Preservation Commission was created by the Blanco City Council in 1986 by the Blanco City Ordinance #263, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BLANCO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 2. Membership on the committee shall be composed of active individuals who have demonstrated knowledge of and vested interest in the historic preservation at the local level.

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) members representing a cross section of the area:

1. A Blanco Historic Preservation Commission member
2. A Blanco business owner
3. A Keep Blanco Beautiful member
4. A member of the Old Blanco County Courthouse Preservation Society
5. A member at Large
6. A Grant Researcher or Writer
7. A Planning & Zoning Commission Member
8. One or two advisors

Further, the City Council shall appoint two (2) members as liaisons to the Streetscape Committee. The City shall appoint a Public Works employee and a City Councilmember as Liaisons to the Committee.

The Committee may augment membership for specific issues as needed.

APPROVED this, the 30 day of November 2021, by a vote of 4 (ayes), 0 (nays) and 1 (abstentions) of the Blanco City Council.
