

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-002

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLANCO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION GRANT AWARD THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) TO PURCHASE BODY-WORN CAMERAS FOR THE BLANCO POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Blanco, Texas, understands the importance of enhancing critical and emergency preparedness, and

**WHEREAS**, the grant award will be used to fund the purchase of Body-Worn Cameras for the Blanco Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Blanco, Texas, agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor (OOG) funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor (OOG) in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Blanco, Texas, hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or his designee, as the City's authorized official, to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLANCO, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the application, acceptance, and implementation of the Body-Worn Camera Grant Program award through the Office of the Governor (OOG) to purchase Body-Worn Camera for the Blanco Police Department.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorized the City Administrator, or his designee, and the City's authorized official to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
